Preserve an Easter Lily: Consider taking a plant home and transplanting it outside after the danger of frost [May 15th]. Select a location close to your foundation which has full or partial sun. Mark the location with a soda straw, as the plant will die back. Easter lilies are not hardy and will not tolerate being planted anywhere like lily bulbs purchased commercially. We have had success with Easter lily transplants along East Hall. They have been there since 2021 and are reappearing for another season.
