GOSPEL READING Mark 6:1-13

[Jesus] came to his hometown, and his disciples followed him.On the sabbath he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were astounded. They said, "Where did this man get all this? What is this wisdom that has been given to him? What deeds of power are being done by his hands! Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon, and are not his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. Then Jesus said to them, "Prophets are not without honor, except in their hometown, and among their own kin, and in their own house." And he could do no deed of power there, except that he laid his hands on a few sick people and cured them. And he was amazed at their unbelief. Then he went about among the villages teaching. He called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. He ordered them to take nothing for their journey except a staff; no bread, no bag, no money in their belts; but to wear sandals and not to put on two tunics. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave the place. If any place will not welcome you and they refuse to hear you, as you leave, shake off the dust that is on your feet as a testimony against them." So they went out and proclaimed that all should repent. They cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

A MOMENT OF CELEBRATION

- P: All baptized Christians are called to share in Christ's ministry of love and service in the world, to the glory of God and for the sake of the human family and the whole creation. According to apostolic usage you have been entrusted with the office of word and sacrament in the one holy catholic church by the laying on of hands and by prayer.
- P: A reading from John: Jesus said, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." (John 20:21-23) Before almighty God, to whom you must give account, and in the presence of this assembly, I ask: Will you continue to tend this office, believing that the church's call is God's call to the ministry of word and sacrament?

Pastor Chris: I will, and I ask God to help me.

P: Will you continue to preach and teach in accordance with the holy scriptures and these creeds and confessions?

P: Almighty God, who has given you the will to do these things, graciously give you the strength and compassion to continue in the office of pastor to the people of Ascension and to all the world.

P: Pastor Chris remember your charge: care for God's people, bear their burdens, and do not betray their confidence. So, discipline *yourselves* in life and teaching that you preserve the truth, giving no occasion for false security or illusory hope. Witness faithfully in word and deed to all people. Give and receive comfort as you serve within the church. And be of good courage, for God has called you, and your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

Pastor Chris: Amen.

- P: And you, assembled as the people of God and speaking for the whole church, will you continue to support Pastor Chris in his call to ministry at Ascension, as *messenger* of Jesus Christ, sent by God to serve all people with the gospel of hope and salvation?
